## Transnational meeting in Athens

## Main findings from the research

**The aim of the project is to highlight the footprint of women in history in cities across Europe.**

In first part of the project, consortium has dived into desk research and organizing focus group with stakeholders and young people. During this research the consortium detected statues and historical areas that represent female figures in history, thus raising awareness about their contribution.

The analysis of the Desk Research indicates that the number of known female figures around European cities is proportionally smaller when compared to the number of known male figures. The most common result is that women were not absent from remarkable times in history and also in contemporary history, rather than marginalised from the dominant narrative.




Even though the National Reports indicate several difficulties and challenges in all partner countries, in conclusion, there is a common point when it comes to the results of the Focus Groups with young people. Young people have a large interest in learning more about female figures in history.



## Next steps in the project

**The project HerStory aims to challenge the narrative that the field of history is male dominated by highlighting women's presence and contributions throughout history.**

Partners are now focusing on finishing with online HerStory map. At the same time consortium is preparing all necessary material for creating Online Platform and Mobile App, where participants will have opportunity to discover who were important woman in history that weren't recognized by society.
