HerStory final conference

The University of Salamanca held the conference 'HerStory: Redefining history through women's voices.

On Tuesday, 5 November, the lecture hall at the Solís building of the Faculty of Education at the University of Salamanca was full of participants and partners involved in the 'HerStory project by highlighting women's contribution to the history of societies' project.

The day began at 10:00, with the opening of Inmaculada Sánchez Barrios from the Equality Unit, Susana Olmos Migueláñez from the University Institute of Education Sciences, Francisco José García Peñalvo, coordinator of the doctoral programme Training in the Knowledge Society, and Alicia García Holgado, representative of the HerStory project.



The event featured presentations on women's achievements and contributions through history and education, beginning with a presentation of the HerStory project itself by Sonia Verdugo Castro from the GRIAL Group of the USAL.



Afterwards, the HerStory experience in Lecco (Italy) was shared, and a team from the project guided the attendees on a virtual tour of the project's cities.

The conference ended with an interactive activity at 17:00, the 'HerStory Gincana', a treasure hunt that invited attendees to playfully delve deeper into the topics covered during the day.



Future actions in the HerStory project

The HerStory project is preparing for its next steps, including finalizing the map, app, and spreading awareness through events and media.

The next steps in the HerStory project involve several important tasks. Partners will continue to develop and update the HerStory Map, creating both local and transnational versions in different languages. The online platform and mobile app will also be further tested and improved. Each partner will gather feedback from participants during final excursions and prepare reports on the outcomes.
